DRIVING TIPS

Consider safety features when purchasing a vehicle.

Maintain your vehicle in a safe operating condition.

Adjust seat and rear view mirrors before starting vehicle.

Fasten and properly adjust your safety belt.

Obey all traffic laws and regulations.

Observe a safe following distance (the two second rule).

Be mentally and physically prepared to drive.

Pass only when safe and necessary.

Always signal your intentions.

Use only low beam headlamps when meeting or following another vehicle.

Keep all window and lights clean clear and operational.

Never drink or take drugs and drive.
